How to Set Up a SC State Constable Online Training Course Account

The purpose of these instructions is to guide you through setting up a user account on the **SC State Constable Online Training Course site**. Moodle is South Carolina ETV's Online Course Management site. This is the course management system the South Carolina Criminal Justice Academy is using to host some of its online and recertification courses.



If <u>http://sledconstabletraining.org/</u> takes you to this page, click on LOG IN.

Click on "CREATE NEW ACCOUNT"

(this is also where you login to the training site after your account is created).



Here is where you setup your username and password for all online courses. Your password needs to be at least 8 characters. One character must be a number and one character must be capitalized. Example: **Mypassword1**





You must check I'm NOT A ROBOT CAPTCHA information (CAPTCHA is a program the system uses to prevent spam accounts), select specified squares and click VERIFY.

If you can't read the CAPTCHA image displayed, click on "Get another CAPTCHA" and another one will pop up. Once you enter and recheck all of your information

If all information is complete and accepted, you see a message indicating an email was sent to the email account you entered.

Click "CONTINUE" on this page then go to your email and open the confirmation email that was automatically sent to you.
